READ John 15.9-17

Jesus talks about the love which comes from the Father to Jesus, then on to his followers, and from them to others. Jesus gives one vital command: to love each another in the same way that he loves us. Obeying this command is not a sign that we are his servants but that we are his chosen friends.

A note on the passage. The focus is on the power of love as seen through friendship with Jesus. It is particularly significant because it comes shortly before the Passion, where Jesus lays down his life for his friends. And this friendship is not casual, it is a covenant relationship; a gracious gift to us from God. Although the disciples are now described as friends, the call to obedience is still vital: it is the loving response of a friend who has been chosen
