Read Matthew 5.1-12

Jesus is on a hillside speaking to a big crowd. He proclaims God's blessing on a list of people and situations where that might seem surprising: mourners, peacemakers and those who are poor in spirit, meek, hungry, merciful, pure in heart and persecuted for the sake of justice.

A note on the passage.

Some of the things Jesus lists are things we can choose to work towards, such as showing mercy or being a peacemaker. Others are things we have no control over: we do not choose when to mourn, for example. Whether we face circumstances of our own choosing, or are faced with things outside our control, when we love God and love our neighbours, we are blessed.
